Global networking — Courses by Romanian and international experts in the migration field.

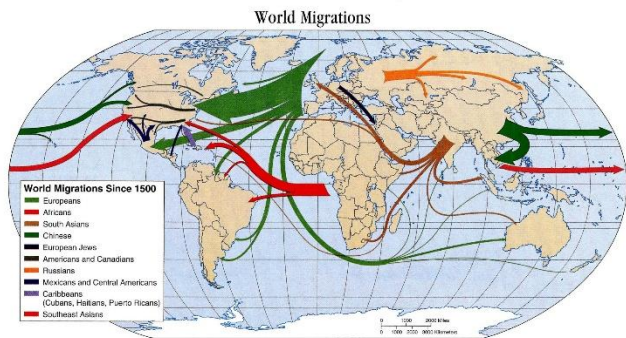
Workshops — On integration, intercultural dialogue, EU policy, and anti-discrimination.
